**Committee Reports:**

**Archery:** Ted reported that the ranges need to be weeded (which he will do).

Glenn P. requested that they use the rifle range on Friday or Saturday, not Sunday.

Ted Pitt made the motion to allow the use and Ken Williams seconded the motion. The board approved the motion unanimously.

**Other Business:** Ken Williams reported that the King County Courthouse called him and said that one of our employees told them that we do not offer Hunter Safety. He let them know that we do and that he was not sure who told them that.

Ken reported that the ISPC shooters on Sunday, June 25<sup>th</sup> were driving too fast and that they generated so much dust that the trap shooters had to wait for it to clear.

Ken reported that someone has been using the skeet range after hours.
