We have hauled in two loads of boards mostly 2x6 to rip for target stand legs. We have one more load. The boards are coming from Lindel Homes. A member Louis works there.

We started doing some spraying of the brush on the shot gun berm and it seems to be working. Now we need a small army to spray around the grounds.

When the action bay is rebuilt, we can start working the area between the 25 & 50 yard lines at the pistol range. It is to rough and to rocky to mow or even walk around with the weeds & grass growing around the area.
