### Grounds Chairman Report, August 8, 2007 Meeting 7:00 PM

1. Repair of front gate, has been completed. We took an old post from down at the rifle range that had 2 feet of cement on the bottom and set the post in about 3 1/2 feet in the ground with 4 sacks of mixed cement. Casey picked up the supplies and we finished it Tuesday the 7/17th.

2. Monday 7/9, we sprayed the Scotch broom on the shot gun burn.

3. A special thanks or letter needs to go out to a member "Tom Stoneking" for the donation of a 10 inch Craftsman table saw to the rifle range for cutting wood for target legs and backers. the saw has had very little use.

4. We checked the septic system at all three locations; Gate House, Club House, and Range Office. All are functioning and look OK.

5. I've posted a job list, here and the rifle range for club improvement, for anyone who is looking for a work hours. If anyone has any more to add let me know.

6. The shed at the pistol range is in some what of a mess. We are building some new shelves on the South out side wall to make more room and we hope to be able to find things easier.

### Renton Fish and Game Club Improvements:

#### Rifle & Pistol Area work list;

- i/w 1. Clean out storage room in range office & move to pistol storage room.
- 2. Close off under stands in rifle range (by red line).
- 3. Pressure wash range office building. Paint office building, green.
- 4. Paint inside range buildings white (pistol & rifle)
- 5. Paint red line in rifle & pistol ranges.
- i/w 6. Remove rocks from front of 100 yard line and 50 meter burm.
- i/w 7. Clean out walk way to target areas , 25 yd. & 50 yd.. pistol range
- 8. Add crushed material to walk way pistol range.
- 9. Add crushed material to road & walk way in rifle range area.
- 10. Cut weeds around back of range office.
- 11. Paint numbers on target lane boards and place in front of 100 yd. line
- 12. Make signs "NO WALKING OR CLIMBING ON BURMS" pistol & rifle range.
- 13. Make arrow direction signs for pistol & rifle ranges.
- i/w 12. Add boards to safety fence on top of 50 yard burm at pistol range.
- 13. Extend board fence on East side of rifle range.
- 14. Dig drainage ditch behind 100 yd.. line.
- 15. Dig drainage ditch and sump hole at bottom of 100 yd.. burm.
- 16. Fill ditches & sump holes with rock and install pipes for drainage.
- i/w 17. Add boards to fence at 50 yard pistol burm
- 18. Spray weeds along ranges and around buildings.
- 19. Remove treated logs from parking area, and grounds (Shot gun & rifle areas.)
- 20. Repair old shooting stools.
- 21. Repair old or build new shooting benches.
- 22. Chip 100 yard and 50 yard and 50 meter burms.
- 23. Chip pistol area behind 25 yard line to 50 yard line and all burms.
- 24. Repair vent fan in ladies rest room.
- 25. Saw up lumber for target legs.
- 26. Saw up boards for target backers.
- 27. Build target stands.
- 28. Build patio and cover.
- 29. Build sand bags.
- 30. Install green slats in fence by back gate.

### Renton Fish and Game Club Improvements:

#### Club House area & Action bay work list:

1. Remove old junk from property. (over side hill, south side parking lot)
2. Remove rocks from parking area & along road.
3. Remove treated logs from parking area, and grounds (Shot gun & rifle areas.) that are not in use.
4. Remove or re-stack pallets.
5. Do something with the old dump truck.
6. Clean up and move hot tar trailer to location not obvious & protected, or get rid of it.
7. Entrances road, trim laurel bush.
8. Level gravel and debris at South West corner & West side under porch of Club house and under front steps and porch.
9. Pressure wash of side walk and stairs at Club house.
10. Paint Club House.
11. Finish inside of shotgun range building.
12. Add board fence on top of new action bay burms.
13. Install new fence by Safety Area end of action bay.
14. Rebuild fence with neighbor (?) by front gate (West side of gate).
15. Clean up the barbecue area.
16. Reroof barbecue cover.
17. Clean out gutters.
18. Cut grass and weeds all around action bays.
19. Spread chips at south end of action bays.

#### Fence Line:

- i/w
1. A long entrance road replace top rails and straighten 2 others (1 left).
  2. Install green slats in fence from bottom of hill to 2nd gate (entrance).
  3. Install green slats in fence. Gate to corner (rifle range).
  4. Trim brush both sides fence line & remove trees off fence along 144th.
  5. A long 144th Street replace top rails. (5) (corner top rail straight)
  6. Remove trees, brush on & along East fence.
  7. Repair fence sections and replace post, East side. (As needed)
