- By the pistol range, the cottonwood tree has been cut down. As of last Wed. the wood and limbs have yet to be removed (Ben had not been told the tree was down).
- Roads have been graded and black topped.
- We have been trying to keep up with target backers and general clean up prior to West match.
- Up by the 275 yard line, there is a dead alder tree up next to the fence that we need to bring down, if it falls on it's own it could damage more of the fence.
- Some one has been shooting at the up right support beams on the pistol range in front of the 50 foot berm, looks like they are using them as targets, also there seems to be more bullet holes in the baffles. Glenn and my crew have been painting the holes to help keep track of the problem.
- Last Monday we sprayed around the Club house and rifle range buildings with Termite and Carpenter ant killer. Jacky said she would take care of the house.
- Aug 17 & 18 we would like to rewire and repair the light on the pole by the rifle range office. Justin Pauly, an electrical contractor will be working with us/or we with him. We plan on repairing the light, remove the pipe and wires from out side the pole and

route them down the inside and under ground to the rifle range then over to the breaker box. We will also sand, prime and paint the pole at this time. Cost will be for the breaker, wiring, paint & primer, if the light is in working order. Then the cost of the light repair. These costs will be Justin's. The cost for a 30 foot lift, we can get one for about \$165 a day. We will be able to keep it for 2 or 3 days at one day charge. We thought of battle ship gray for the color for the pole. We know the pole can be lowered, but the main power lines would have to be disconnected and the pole raised each night and wires re-hooked up. With the added danger to equipment and us we elected to use the lift.

If whole light needs replaced \$380 + freight (4 to 5 weeks to get here).

We won't know what's up until we get up to the light to check it out.

**Decision:** the Board approved the repairs and authorized up to \$500

- I will be meeting with Rob Bale on painting tomorrow morning to recap the painting. He is planning on start cleaning Monday or Tuesday next week and painting the following Monday. I need to have the paint chips for the club house and what trim we want. I would also like to give him the combination to the front gate, so they can work on their schedule. Also he would like a check for half, he said he would give me the invoice to start and when finished he would give us the final billing. So I'll request \$1500 to start.

**Decision:** the Board approved the funding

- It was pointed out that the pistol range is very rutted between the 25 and 50 yard positions from our Spring work party.
