- Our most recent match was November 14th, when we started this seasons IDPA Night Shoots. The weather was cold but clear. This is a controlled group by "invitation only". This occasion had 13 participants. We set up 2 stages & by flashlight practiced target identification & shooting.
- Our most recent match was November 21st, the weather was very cool but had just enough precipitation that we kept the cardboard targets in day cleaner bags. There were 67 shooters, of which we had additional competitors from at least Canada & California. There were seven stages with great scenarios & a minimum count of 88 rounds required for the course. The "Back Up Gun side stage" that was cancelled in October was run in November. 13 shooters stayed & participated in the additional 2 stages & 10 more rounds of shooting. All participants had an enjoyable and safe time. \$660 dollars were turned into the club.
