- For the month of February we cancelled the night shoot that was to be on Saturday the 13th. It rained for several days prior & continued thru that Saturday.
- Our regular Saturday monthly match was on the 20<sup>th</sup>. It was a cool day but clear with a little sunshine. We had seven stages and set a new record for participants with 113. \$1014 was turned into the club.  
We also did a Shotgun Side Stage afterwards, and had ~20 participants. It ran from 2:30 to 4:30.
- The next scheduled events for March are a Night Shoot on the 13<sup>th</sup> & our regular 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday event will be on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
