- Our regular Saturday monthly match was on the 20th. We had six stages and 104 participants. \$1020 was turned into the club.
- The next scheduled events for April will be the commencement of regular Thursday Practices beginning on the 8th, and then our regular Saturday match on the 17th.

Easier, less cement, less digging.....Won't go deep enough to require a test hole. Has several options, his piece and foundation blueprint is \$1100.
